Social Emotional Learning	The Early Learners Classroom uses the Character Counts Pillars of Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Caring, Fairness, and Community. These ideals are reinforced daily through stories, rhymes, songs and conversations. Program staff work with students to learn pro-social behaviors and to practice them in a peer environment. These include sharing, apologizing, taking turns, cleaning up, respecting authority, and self confidence.
